**DISCUSSION:** We are scheduling a reception on Tuesday, February 6 in the Vola Lawson Lobby to honor Planning Commission Chairman Bill Hurd, who has advised us that he will not be reapplying for another term on the Planning Commission. Mr. Hurd has devoted countless volunteer hours to the City as a member and chairman of the Planning Commission, and Council, the Planning Commission, and members of the community will have the opportunity to recognize him on February 6.
