

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Alexandria Technology Achievement Week, March 12-16, is a showcase for Alexandria's expanding technology sector, including more than 400 technology firms that employ nearly 120,000 full-time employees; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria has joined with the Alexandria Chamber of Commerce and the Alexandria Economic Development Partnership, Inc., to sponsor the 5th Annual Alexandria Technology Achievement Award; and

WHEREAS, the four finalists for the 2000 Alexandria Technology Achievement Award, as selected by a panel of distinguished judges, are:

A.B. FLOYD ENTERPRISES, INC., for providing solutions in systems integration software and network engineering, and information systems security and for helping the United Negro College Fund to determine the technology needs at historically black colleges and universities; and

CARNEY INTERACTIVE, INC., for combining leading-edge technologies with instructional design, digital artistry and software engineering to create the most effective customer e-Learning solutions for corporate and government clients; and

DIGITAL PAPER CORPORATION, for their development of the docQuest family of solutions to simplify the way companies do business by allowing complex technical documents, such as engineering drawings, to be sent quickly and securely over the Internet; and

SEGUE TECHNOLOGIES, INC., for the design and manufacture of the Sentinel Police Information Management System, a seamless incident management and mobile data application enabling law enforcement agencies to create a virtual mobile office for the police officer in the field; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children was singled out by the Technology Achievement Award judges for special recognition for serving as a national clearinghouse for information on missing and exploited children and for creating a web site (www.missingkids.org) to supply an online, multilingual database of missing children cases and information on child sexual exploitation worldwide; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to recognize the importance of technology to the City and its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KERRY J. DONLEY, Mayor of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and on behalf of the Alexandria City Council do hereby proclaim this week to be "Alexandria Technology Achievement Week" and congratulate A.B.
