## **Directions to Ben Brenman Park**

Ben Brenman Park is located off the 5000 block of Duke Street.

### **From the capital Beltway (I-95 and I-495):**

Take Exit 177B (Route 1 North). Follow Route 1 until you reach Duke Street (Route 236); turn left (West) onto Duke Street. Watch for the brown Ben Brenman sign; follow the sign and turn right. This is the first right past the Foxchase Shopping Center. Drive over the bridge to the Stop sign. Turn right, then turn left onto Somerville Street. Take the last left. The performance space is near the pond, at the far end of the parking lot.

### **From the Landmark area, heading East:**

Take Duke Street to just past Somerville Street. On your right is the entrance to the park, marked by the brown Ben Brenman sign. Turn right. Drive over the bridge to the Stop sign. Turn right, then turn left onto Somerville Street. Take the last left. The performance space is near the pond, at the far end of the parking lot.

## **Directions to the King Street Gardens Park**

The King Street Gardens Park is at 1806 King Street, in the upper King Street area.

### **From the capital Beltway (I-95 and I-495):**

Take Exit 177B (Route 1 North). Follow Route 1 until you reach King Street. Turn left onto King.

### **From Washington, D.C.:**

Take the George Washington Parkway south. The Parkway becomes N. Washington Street upon entering Alexandria. Follow Washington Street to King Street. Turn right onto King.
