SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL SCHEDULE

ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council:

- (1) receive the revised calendar which includes:
 - the Wednesday, February 13 joint meeting with the School Board and the Electoral Board at 7:30 p.m. at Samuel Tucker School;
 - the Saturday, March 2 St. Patrick's Day Parade (time to be determined);
 - the Tuesday, March 12 Alexandria Technology Achievement Awards reception at 6:45 p.m. in the Vola Lawson Lobby;
 - the Thursday, March 21 Alexandria Technology Achievement Awards breakfast at 7:30 a.m. at the Mark Center Hilton; and
 - the Friday, March 22 Alexandria Technology Achievement Awards luncheon at noon at the Old Town Hilton; and
- (2) schedule a community meeting at Patrick Henry School at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 21 or Wednesday, May 22.

DISCUSSION: The 2002 Alexandria Technology Achievement Awards, recognizing Alexandria-based companies who exemplify exceptional development of new technology or the innovative use of existing technology, will be presented during Alexandria Technology Achievement Week, March 18-22. The Awards breakfast will be held on Tuesday, March 21 at 7:30 a.m. at the Mark Center Hilton and the Awards luncheon will be held at noon at the Old Town Hilton.

The updated calendar also includes the location for the Monday, March 25 Alexandria Commission for Women's Annual Salute for Women Awards (the Holiday Inn Hotel and Suites at 625 First Street).

At the January 8 legislative meeting Council requested that staff propose dates for a community meeting in the spring following adoption of the FY 2003 budget. We propose that the community meeting be held at Patrick Henry School on either Tuesday, May 21 or Wednesday, May 22.
