SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL SCHEDULE

ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council:

- (1) receive the revised calendar which includes:
 - *Christmas in April* on Saturday, April 27 (time and location to be determined);
 - Alexandria's 2002 *Successful Aging Expo* and Awards Presentation at the Holiday Inn Hotel and Suites, 625 First Street, on Thursday, May 9 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.; and
 - City Council's community meeting at Patrick Henry Elementary School at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 22;
- (2) schedule a work session to discuss Woodrow Wilson Bridge noise mitigation issues at 6 p.m. before Council's Tuesday, February 26 legislative meeting; and
- (3) schedule the annual meeting of the Alexandria Transit Company Board of Directors at 7:15 p.m. on Tuesday, February 26 in the Council Workroom, immediately after the proposed work session to discuss Woodrow Wilson Bridge noise issues.

DISCUSSION: Councilman Euille has requested that Council hold a work session to discuss noise mitigation issues regarding the Woodrow Wilson Bridge. I propose the work session be held at 6 p.m. before Council's Tuesday, February 26 legislative meeting.

Each winter, Council, acting as the Board of Directors of the Alexandria Transit Company, holds a brief annual meeting. I recommend that the meeting be scheduled at 7:15 p.m. immediately after the February 26 work session to discuss Woodrow Wilson Bridge issues.

Christmas in April, the annual one-day home repair program for income-eligible City owner-occupants repairs at no cost to the homeowner, will be held on Saturday, April 27.

The Alexandria 2002 *Successful Aging Expo* and Awards Presentation, a partnership with community-spirited businesses and non-profit agencies, is scheduled for Thursday, May 9 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Holiday Inn Hotel and Suites, 625 First Street. The theme is "It's About Time," and the Expo will feature a continental breakfast, trade show, notable speakers including The Honorable Belle Wheelan, Secretary of Education for the Commonwealth of Virginia and Dr. Leo Frangiapane, Jr., author of the best selling book, "Touchstones and Wellsprings, the Survivor's Guide," and interactive seminars. The Commission on Aging will also present its annual service awards at the opening session.

At the January 22 legislative meeting Council voted to schedule the community meeting for Wednesday, May 22 at Patrick Henry School, and this has been added to the calendar.
