Dear Mayor Donley and Members of the Alexandria City Council:

I am writing in support of the nomination of Ms. Kathleen Burns to the Alexandria Consumer Affairs Commission.

A long-time Virginia resident, she has been active in a wide swath of community service projects, including 20 years of involvement with the Brookville-Seminary Valley Civic Association. She served as an officer for 8 years, before an overseas posting, and rejoined the board last year as vice president.

As a journalist with extensive experience as well as someone with Capital Hill experience, she is familiar with doing investigations, organizing hearings, writing reports and making recommendations. Those would always be useful skills for such a board.

She also has had board service in Alexandria, serving as the first woman in the 52 years of its existence on the Alexandria Parking and Traffic Board. She was unanimously appointed by the Council. Certainly, parking and traffic have become some of the most difficult issues in our community. She demonstrated a keen sense of empathy yet a fair and equitable approach to these difficult matters.

As a parent of a young child, she is also involved in aspects of health and safety in Alexandria that affect families and this would be potential fertile ground for problems that might come before the Consumer Affairs Board.
