TKC, the contractor for the bridge foundations, expects to start driving piles for the fenders around the channel piers during the week of January 20. This work will be completed in approximately two months, weather permitting. There are 48 of these 54 inch diameter, 155 feet long steel pipe piles. They will be using a compressed air pile hammer and expect the noise level to be relatively high, but the time to actually drive these shorter piles should be less than it was for the pier foundation piles. Pile driving will be limited to daylight hours. No Sunday work is anticipated.
