In the absence of evidence that Iraq, unlike North Korea, possesses weapons of mass destruction; the lack of hostile action by Iraq toward the United States and its neighbors; the absence of Iraqi missiles capable of reaching the United States and threatening its national interest; the unconvincing evidence presented thusfar that Iraq is currently developing weapons of mass destruction; the dubious validity of preemption by the world's only superpower; the lack of evidence that Iraq is tied to known terrorists; the weak and deteriorating U.S. economy and the lack of information on the likely cost of the proposed war to the U.S.; the paucity of committed allies; the seeming lack of concern for the suffering of civilians; the lack of knowledge to prevent a recurrence of the severe damage from Gulf War syndrome in the same area; a recurrence of the damage to the environment and the opposition to the proposed near- unilateral decision of the current administration to attack with or without United Nations approval demonstrated by larger numbers of Americans and citizens of other nations, the Alexandria City Council resolves that it opposes war against Iraq at this time.
