I respectfully request that my position, designated by the City Council as a liaison seat for a representative from the Alexandria Gay and Lesbian Community Association, be posted as vacant until a new representative is named by AGLCA.

Unfortunately, AGLCA is experiencing membership/leadership difficulties which endanger its continuation. The terms of the current Board of Directors have expired without candidates for replacement. The current Board members have agreed to continue serving until May, at which time the organization may disband. This calls into question the designation of a Commission seat for the AGLCA; an issue which you may want to address in the near future. The Commission may want to contact the current AGLCA President, Emmanuel Vaughn (703-461-8251) in May to determine the outcome of the AGLCA Board's action.
