**ISSUE:** City Council Schedule.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:** That City Council:

- (1) schedule a work session on Upper Potomac West at 6:00 p.m. before Council's Tuesday, October 8 legislative meeting;
- (2) schedule a work session on Eisenhower East at 6:00 p.m. before Council's Tuesday, December 10 legislative meeting; and
- (3) note the following events that have been added to the Council Calendar:
  - the ribbon cutting ceremony and grand opening kickoff of the Eisenhower Recycling Center on Saturday, October 19, at 8:30 a.m.;
  - a work session on the Eisenhower-to-Duke Connector before Council's Wednesday, October 23 legislative session, at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers;
  - a Special Public Hearing on the Eisenhower-to-Duke Connector on Tuesday, October 29 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers; and
  - the Scottish Christmas Walk parade on Saturday, December 7 (time to be determined).

**DISCUSSION:** The revised calendar includes the ribbon cutting ceremony and grand opening kickoff at the Eisenhower Recycling Center that will take place on Saturday, October 19, at 8:30 a.m. Two Council work sessions need to be scheduled for later in the fall - one on Upper Potomac West and one on the Eisenhower East Plan. I recommend that Council schedule the work session on Upper Potomac West on Tuesday, October 8 and the work session on the proposed Eisenhower East Plan on Tuesday, December 10.
