

Dear Mr. Mayor and Councilmembers,

I **strongly endorse** the application by **Sally Ann Greer** for reappointment to the *Urban Design Advisory Committee for Old Town North (UDAC - OTN)* to a "**resident**" seat.

Dr. Sally Ann Greer has been active in Old Town North civic issues since 1985. She is co-founder and president of North Old Town Independent Citizens (NOTIC) civic association and president of Canal Way Condo Association. She participated in the Old Town North Small Area Plan Task Force, closely followed the Washington Street Guidelines update, is a decade-long supporter of Save the George Washington Parkway, and is a member and former president of the Northern Virginia Society of Clinical Psychologists. She believes that residents representing residential interests have a role to play in the continuing positive development of Old Town North.

Residents should represent residents. Sally Ann Greer is currently on the *UDAC - OTN* where she has been serving as the first truly resident member who has represented **residential** interests and has also fairly treated business concerns. She has made important contributions to the recent work of the *UDAC - OTN* including the Old Colony Inn redevelopment project.

Prior to Sally Ann Greer's current appointment as a **resident** member, the *UDAC - OTN* had been only comprised of people who were also members of the Old Town North Community Association (OTNCA), a **business-resident** group of which developers such as Saul Center are dues-paying members. The OTNCA group has supported denser development (2.5 vs. 1.5 floor area ratio) in past projects when residents' civic associations were in opposition, and supported the developer against adjacent residents in Saul Center's request to amend its permit. As you are aware, because of the pro-developer bias of the OTNCA, members broke off and formed NOTIC, the civic association which solely represents the residents of Old Town North. When the City Council first appointed Sally Ann Greer to the *UDAC - OTN*, this pro-business monopoly was corrected.

I believe **Sally Ann Greer** is the best candidate to continue to represent the **residents** of Old Town North.
