This is to request that you and Members of City Council reappoint Jeffrey McAllister, an outstanding, active, productive and effective member, to the Alexandria Commission on Persons with Disabilities (ACPD) for a full term at the March 9, 2004 meeting of City Council. A young man with an extremely sever disability, Jeff McAllister has quickly established himself as a leader on the Commission. This young man brought the issue of captioning televised meetings of City Council to the attention of the Commission. That set the stage for the preparation of the plan to caption televised Council meetings in the early Spring of 2004. He has been extremely helpful to the Commission and the Registrar of Voters Office in providing technical assistance and guidance to evaluate the most accessible electronic voting machines. He has provided valuable guidance to the vendor as well as the Registrar of Voters Office in the training in the use of the accessible voting machines for staff and poll workers

Experienced in a wide array of accessibility issues, he has provided input on making the King Street Concourse accessible and recommended that accessible buses be used to ferry persons from PTO to the King Street Metro. Jeff actively made suggestions regarding the plans to make the proposed T. C. Williams High School as accessible as possible, as well as the main entrance to City Hall, among other key projects.

Not content with providing expert advice on key construction and renovation projects, Jeff volunteered to be a reader of nominations for the Disability Awards, a joint effort between the Commission and Chamber of Commerce, which highlight exceptional business employment and service practices for individuals with disabilities. These awards are presented annually at a reception sponsored by the Chamber in November. Additionally, he is an active member of the Fund Raising Committee which raises funds for the Commission's annual Awards Ceremony held each June.

I am sure that I have left out many of Jeff's contributions to the Commission and to this City, but as you can determine from this brief sample of Jeff's many contributions, this young man has earned the right to your confidence and full support for he is the kind of citizen volunteer that Alexandria takes pride in.
