This letter is written on behalf of Franklyn M. Malone to support his reappointment to the Alexandria Employment Commission.

Mr. Malone is the Public Housing Drug Elimination Program (PHDEP) coordinator for the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority (ARHA) and is responsible for planning, organizing, budgeting, and coordinating all aspects of administration and operation of the PHDEP grant awarded to ARHA by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
