

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Alexandria City Council approved the promotion of homeownership as a policy objective in 1994; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to show potential home buyers that, with interest rates at very low levels, affordable homeownership is possible for low and moderate income purchasers, even in the current Alexandria housing market; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to assist public employees, including City and school employees, in purchasing their first home in the community that they are serving; and

WHEREAS, during calendar year 2005 the City is offering reduced interest rate mortgage financing through the Sponsoring Partnerships and Revitalizing Communities (SPARC) program of the Virginia Housing Development Authority (VHDA) to all City loan program participants; and

WHEREAS, during calendar year 2005 the City is offering second trust financing through the Home Stride Program of VHDA to all City loan program participants and to public employees who meet VHDA eligibility criteria; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to inform potential home buyers of the many new and improved affordable financing mechanisms, to make eligible participants aware of the City's assistance programs, to share other useful information about the home buying process, and to provide prospective homebuyers with an opportunity to interact with lenders and real estate agents concerning their individual home purchase needs; and

WHEREAS, to help accomplish these goals, the City will hold its Eleventh Annual Homeownership Fair on Saturday, April 9, 2005 at George Washington Middle School from 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WILLIAM D. EUILLE, Mayor of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and on behalf of the Alexandria City Council, do hereby proclaim Saturday, April 9, 2005 as:

“HOMEOWNERSHIP FAIR DAY”

in the City of Alexandria.
