SUBJECT: BUDGET MEMO # 136 : REAL ESTATE TAX RATES

The following table provides a status of real estate tax rates for Northern Virginia jurisdictions, including the tax rate proposed for calendar year 2006, the rate adopted (if available), and the change from calendar year 2005.

If Council adopts a rate of 81.5 cents, that rate will be the second lowest among the major jurisdictions in Northern Virginia, below Arlington, Fairfax County and Loudoun County and just 8/10 tenths of one cent above Prince William County.

At this point, all jurisdictions except Falls Church have adopted their tax rates. Falls Church is scheduled to adopt its tax rate on the date listed above.
