SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL SCHEDULE

ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council:

- schedule a work session to discuss issues regarding Virginia Paving at 7:00 p.m. on either Tuesday, May 30 or Wednesday, May 31 in the Council work room; and
- receive the revised calendar which includes the following additions:
 - a reception sponsored by the George Washington Birthday Celebration Committee before Council's Tuesday, May 9 legislative meeting at 5:30 p.m. in the Vola Lawson Lobby;
 - a reception sponsored by the Youth Policy Commission to honor youth as part of the annual National Youth Service Day observance on Thursday, May 18 at 6:00 p.m. in the Vola Lawson Lobby (rescheduled from Tuesday, April 25);
 - the Alexandria Waterfront Festival kickoff party on Wednesday, June 14 from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Torpedo Factory; and
 - the 25th Annual Alexandria Red Cross Waterfront Festival on Saturday, June 17 and Sunday, June 18 at Oronoco Bay Park.

DISCUSSION: The Planning and Zoning staff is scheduling a community meeting on Virginia Paving before the special use permit is docketed for the June Planning Commission meeting. Following the community meeting I recommend that Council schedule a work session in late May before the Planning Commission meeting.

The George Washington Birthday Celebration Committee will hold a reception at 5:30 p.m. before Council's Tuesday, May 9 legislative meeting in the Vola Lawson Lobby. The purpose of the reception is to recognize parade winners and display this year's parade photos.

The National Youth Service Day reception sponsored by the Youth Policy Commission to honor youth for their community service, previously scheduled for Tuesday, April 25, 2005 has been rescheduled for Thursday, May 18, 2006 at 6:00 p.m., in the Vola Lawson Lobby.

The 25th Annual Alexandria Red Cross Waterfront Festival will take place at Oronoco Bay Park on Saturday, June 17 from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., and Sunday, June 18 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.. A kickoff party for the festival will take place on Wednesday, June 14 from 6:30 to 9:00 p.m. at the Torpedo Factory.
