SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL SCHEDULE

ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council received the revised schedule which includes:

- the Virginia Municipal League Day on Thursday, February 9, 2006, at the Richmond Marriott, 500 East Broad Street; with a joint dinner with Arlington County and the legislative delegations from Alexandria and Arlington at 6:00 p.m. at the Jefferson Hotel, 101 W. Franklin Street.

DISCUSSION: Each year during the Virginia General Assembly session the Virginia Municipal League and Virginia Association of Counties host a legislative day to brief local officials on the issues before the legislature. In the past few years, City Council and the Arlington County Board have hosted a joint dinner for the City and County legislative delegations. This year's Legislative Day will be held on Thursday, February 9 in Richmond, and the dinner will be held that evening.

Councilman Krupicka has requested a Council work session with the Open Space Committee. Staff will be prepared to discuss this request at Council's Wednesday legislative meeting.
