**WHEREAS**, *this year's Rebuilding Together Alexandria workday on April 28, 2007 will mark its 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, working on its 1,000<sup>th</sup> unit nearly 1,000 volunteers; and*

**WHEREAS**, *Rebuilding Together Alexandria has expanded its services to include a year round repair program for those in need; and*

**WHEREAS**, *all funds required for Rebuilding Together Alexandria projects are raised through private and corporate donations, fund-raisers, City and national grants; and*

**WHEREAS**, *Saturday, April 28, 2007, has been designated as Rebuilding Together Alexandria Day in the City of Alexandria, and all persons are encourage to participate in this effort whereby neighbors are helping neighbors across the City and throughout the United States;*

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, WILLIAM D. EUILLE**, Mayor of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and on behalf of the Alexandria City Council, do hereby endorse the continued participation of all Alexandrians in:
