SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL SCHEDULE

ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council:

- (1) Schedule a work session on the Capital Improvement Program from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on both Tuesday, September 18 and Wednesday, September 19 in the Sister Cities Conference Room;
- (2) Schedule a City Boards and Commissions Appreciation Reception at 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, September 20 (location to be determined with a back-up date of Wednesday, September 26);
- (3) Hold the time and date for the annual work session with the General Assembly Delegation (5:30 p.m. before Council's Tuesday, November 27 legislative meeting); and
- (4) Receive the revised calendar which includes:
 - the Spin City 2009 luncheon with director of League of American Bicyclists Andy Clarke as speaker on Friday, June 1 at 12:00 p.m. in the Sister Cities Conference Room.

DISCUSSION: We would like to set the dates for Council's planned fall discussion of the Capital Improvement Program(CIP). Since September is a very busy month with many scheduled weekend events, I recommend that we schedule these important discussions on two weekday nights, Tuesday, September 18 and Wednesday, September 19.

From time to time Council has held a reception to recognize the hundreds of citizen volunteers who serve on our boards and commissions. The Mayor has suggested that Council schedule such a reception on Thursday, September 20 (first choice) or on Wednesday, September 26. In the past we have had the reception at the Torpedo Factory Art Center jointly with the Alexandria Volunteer Bureau. We are exploring doing this again in September and will provide Council with further details when they are available.
