ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council receive the revised calendar which includes:

- the grand opening celebration and ribbon cutting for the Lee Center's new Therapeutic Recreation wing at 8:30 a.m. before Council's Saturday, November 18 public hearing meeting at 1108 Jefferson Street;
- the Mayor's 3rd Annual Unity Breakfast on Wednesday, November 22 at 8:00 a.m. at the Mark Center Hilton, 5000 Seminary Road; and
- the Virginia Municipal League (VML) Day on Thursday, February 1, 2007, at the Richmond Marriott, 500 East Broad Street; with a joint dinner with the Arlington County Board and the legislative delegations from Alexandria and Arlington at 6:00 p.m. at the Jefferson Hotel, 101 West Franklin Street.

DISCUSSION: The grand opening celebration and ribbon cutting for the Lee Center's new Therapeutic Recreation wing is scheduled at 8:30 a.m. before Council's Saturday, November 18 public hearing meeting at the Lee Center, 1108 Jefferson Street. Those in attendance will be able to tour the new rooms, which include the sensory room that was made possible through donations from the Kelley Cares Foundation which was formed in memory of the late Kelley Swanson, a 2005 T.C. Williams High School graduate.

The Mayor's 3rd Annual Unity Breakfast is set for Wednesday, November 22 at 8:00 a.m. at the Mark Center Hilton and has been added to the calendar.

Each year during the Virginia General Assembly session the Virginia Municipal League and Virginia Association of Counties host a legislative day to brief local officials on the issues before the legislature. In the past few years, City Council and the Arlington County Board have hosted a joint dinner for the City and County legislative delegations. This year's Legislative Day will be held on Thursday, February 1 in Richmond, and the dinner will be held that evening.
