SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL SCHEDULE

ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council:

- (1) Schedule a work session on Virginia Paving at 7:00 pm on either Monday, November 6 or Monday, November 13 in the Council Chambers;
- (2) Schedule a meeting of the Alexandria Transit Company Stockholders at 7:00 p.m. just prior to the beginning of Council's Tuesday, November 14 legislative meeting; and
- (3) Note the revised calendar includes the Grand Opening of the Stabler-Leadbetter Apothecary Museum on Saturday, November 11 at 10:00 a.m. at 105-107 South Fairfax Street.

DISCUSSION: At its October 14 public hearing meeting Council deferred action on the special use permit for Virginia Paving and requested that staff schedule a work session. I propose that Council schedule the work session either on Monday, November 6 or Monday, November 13 at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers. We expect to docket the Virginia Paving Special Use Permit on Council's November 28 legislative meeting agenda.

Council needs to meet as the stockholders of the Alexandria Transit Company to fill two vacancies created by the retirement of Chairman William Hurd and the death of Peter Schumaier. Board Chairman Justin Wilson has asked that Council hold a stockholders meeting just prior to its Tuesday, November 14 legislative meeting.

The Stabler-Leadbetter Apothecary Museum will be completed and ready for an opening reception on Saturday, November 11, and we have added this to the calendar.
