SUBJECT:

ORDINANCES REGARDING THE CARRYING OF FIREARMS

<u>ISSUE</u>: State statute now prohibits localities from generally regulating the carrying of firearms in public places except in certain specifically defined circumstances. Alexandria City Code Sections 6-1-1.1 and 13-2-4 currently do not comply with relevant state law.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Amend and repeal the City Code Sections.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: Virginia now generally prohibits localities from regulating the possession of firearms in public with certain specifically defined exceptions. The first code section at issue prohibited persons from carrying a loaded firearm near public parks and the second generally prohibited the carrying of a loaded firearm in public. Both sections violate current state law. This year, the state legislature added a section to the applicable law which provides for the award of attorneys fees and costs to a person who successfully challenges any offending local ordinance.
