<u>ISSUE</u>: Consideration of a text amendment to allow administrative approval of certain signs in the Historic Districts.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council pass the proposed ordinance (Attachment I) on first reading on December 8, 2009 and schedule it for public hearing, second reading and final passage on December 12, 2009.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: This text amendment was recommended to the City Council for approval by the Planning Commission on November 5, 2009, which recommendation was approved by City Council at the public hearing on November 21, 2009. The proposed ordinance implements the City Council's approval.
