CENSUS

ISSUE: Staff report 2010 Alexandria census data.

RECOMMENDATION: That Council receive the attached chart and update from staff.

BACKGROUND: The first 2010 Census data (attached) for Alexandria shows continued growth along a long-term trend averaging about 1% per year since 1960. Over the past 10 years, the Census shows modest shifts in the City's population by race and ethnicity and as to where various groups live, but no dramatic changes in the structure or distribution of these groups.

Staff will present additional details and analysis from the 2010 Census and the American Community Survey at Council's February 22 legislative meeting, including maps and charts describing the City's population and comparing the data and changes in Alexandria to those in the region and the nation.





Percent Change in Population Census 2000 to Census 2010





- Data on income, housing cost, disability, commuting, industry of employment, job categories, more, to block group


Percent of Population Age 5 to 19 Years American Community Survey 2005 - 2009 5-year Average




Percent Foreign Born American Community Survey 2005-2009 Average
