SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL SCHEDULE

ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council:

- 1. Confirm that there will be a budget work session with the School Board at George Washington Middle School on March 30 at 7 p.m. as discussed at the March 14 Joint Budget work session with the School Board;
- 2. Schedule a special executive session at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Workroom on Tuesday, April 5 to discuss personnel matters related to the recruitment and selection of a new city manager;
- 3. Schedule a work session with the Alexandria HIV/AIDS Task Force in the City Council Workroom at 5:30 p.m. before Council's Tuesday, June 14 legislative meeting; and
- 4. Note that the following events that have been added to the Council Calendar since the last legislative meeting:
 - The annual City Employee Recognition Program on Thursday, April 21 from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. at the George Washington Masonic Memorial;
 - The City employee Health Fair on Wednesday, May 11 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Lee Center; and
 - The Commission for the Arts annual Grantee and Artists Recognition Reception on Monday, May 23 at 7 p.m. in City Hall Room 2000.

DISCUSSION:

On March 14 at the joint Budget Work Session, Council confirmed with the School Board that a second joint budget work session will be held on Wednesday, March 30. The meeting location will be the Alliance for Learning and Leading Center on the third floor of George Washington Middle School.

Council has decided to schedule a special executive session on Tuesday, April 5 to discuss personnel matters related to the recruitment and selection of a new City Manager. Since the Jaycees Community Appreciation Night is scheduled for 7 p.m. that night in City Hall, the executive session would start at 7:30 p.m. The April 5 Executive Session will be a continuation of the Executive Session that will be held on Tuesday, March 22 on this personnel matter.

The Department of Human Resources organizes the annual City Employee Recognition Program, which recognizes City employees for their tenure with the City government. In prior years, the awards ceremony and reception has been held at Lee Center. This year, the event will be held in the Memorial Theater at the Masonic Memorial on April 21.

The Mayor has asked that staff schedule a work session with the Alexandria HIV/AIDS Task Force. I recommend that Council schedule the work session at 5:30 p.m. before Council's June 14 legislative meeting as the date for this work session.
