11 12 13 14		(a) <u>Application and approval process</u> . An application for an A- frame sign permit shall be submitted and shall include a plan reasonably depicting the location, size, text,			
15 16		appearance and method of installation of the proposed sign to be located in the public right of way, and such			
17 18		additional information as the Director may reasonably require. The Director may approve the application after			
19 20		determining that the proposed sign plan will be reasonable, attractive and promote pedestrian and retail vitality in the
