SUBJECT:	ANNUAL COMMITTEE ATTENDANCE REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010

**ISSUE:** Receipt of the Annual Report on Committee Attendance for Fiscal Year 2010.

**<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>**: That City Council: (1) receive the report (Attachment 1); (2) vacate the 13 positions listed on pages one and two of the report; and (3) authorize the City Clerk and Clerk of Council to advertise the vacancies.

**DISCUSSION:** Section 2-4-7(i) of the City Code requires appointees to committees to attend at least 75 percent of the meetings of the committees on which they serve. There are 55 City boards, committees, commissions and task forces that are required to file annual attendance reports with the Executive Secretary for Boards and Commissions by July 15 of each year. This report summarizes attendance reports from 41 of the 55 City boards, committees and commissions. The 14 committees that have not submitted the attendance reports for Fiscal Year 2010 are listed on page four of the attachment. When all 14 committee reports are received, staff will docket a supplemental attendance report for Council's consideration.

The 55 City boards, committees, and commissions included in this report held 396 meetings. Ten of the 41 groups listed members (a total of 13 persons) who did not attend 75 percent of the groups' meetings (two less than last year). The names of the persons removed for failure to comply with the attendance requirements are listed on pages one and two of the attached report. Each of the 13 persons has been notified by letter of their attendance record. These persons may reapply for reappointment with other new applicants when the positions are advertised by the City Clerk.
