**ISSUE:** City Council Schedule.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:** That City Council:

- change the date for Council's December legislative meeting from Tuesday, December 9 to Monday, December 8;
- (2) schedule a work session on the Visitors Center proposal at 6:00 p.m. before Council's Monday, December 8 legislative meeting;
- change the date and time for Council's December public hearing meeting from 9:30 a.m. Saturday, December 13 to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 16;
- (3) receive the revised schedule which includes:
  - the Fire Department's Annual Wreath Laying Memorial Ceremony on Friday, October 10 at 11:00 a.m. at Ivy Hill Cemetery, 2823 King Street, with lunch to follow at the First Baptist Church of Alexandria, 2932 King Street;
  - the annual City Council Retreat on Friday, November 7 from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Lloyd House, 220 N. Washington Street; and on Saturday, November 8 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the G.W. Middle School library, 1005 Mt. Vernon Avenue;
  - the dedication of the Patent and Trade Office Building at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 4; and
  - the Virginia Municipal League Legislative Day on Thursday, February 12, 2004 in Richmond (Time and exact location to be determined.).

**DISCUSSION:** Because of the conflict with the annual National League of Cities Conference in December I recommend that Council change the dates of its legislative and public hearing meetings in December. The Tuesday, December 9 legislative meeting would be changed to Monday, December 8 and the Saturday, December 13 public hearing meeting would be changed to 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 16.

The Mayor's office has been advised by PTO staff that the dedication of PTO is scheduled for 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 4. I will provide Council with further details when they are available.

Council has requested that we hold a work session on the Visitors Center proposal, and I recommend that the work session be held at 6:00 p.m. before Council's Monday, December 8 legislative meeting. The public hearing on the Visitor Center proposal is expected to be held at Council's December public hearing meeting.
