RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE SANITARY SEWER LINE

MAINTENANCE CHARGE

**ISSUE:** Increase the sanitary sewer line maintenance charge.

**RECOMMENDATION:** That City Council adopt the attached Resolution.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The sanitary sewer line maintenance charge (i.e. usage fee) was established to assist in recovering the cost of maintaining, inspecting and improving public sanitary sewer facilities in the City. The current rate (\$1.00 per 1,000 gallons of usage) costs the typical household approximately \$70 annually, or \$17.50 per quarter. The sanitary sewer rate is intended to recover 100% of sanitary sewer operating, debt service, and capital costs. This is considered a "best practice" and is the norm in the United States and many other countries. The \$0.25 per 1,000 gallon increase currently proposed would cost the typical household an additional \$17.50 per year, or \$4.38 per quarter. Without the proposed increase, future sanitary sewer capital projects would be deferred or cancelled. The proposed rate was included in the City's FY 2011 Adopted Budget.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The additional projected revenue in FY 2011 from increasing the sanitary sewer maintenance fee to \$1.25 is \$1.312,500.
