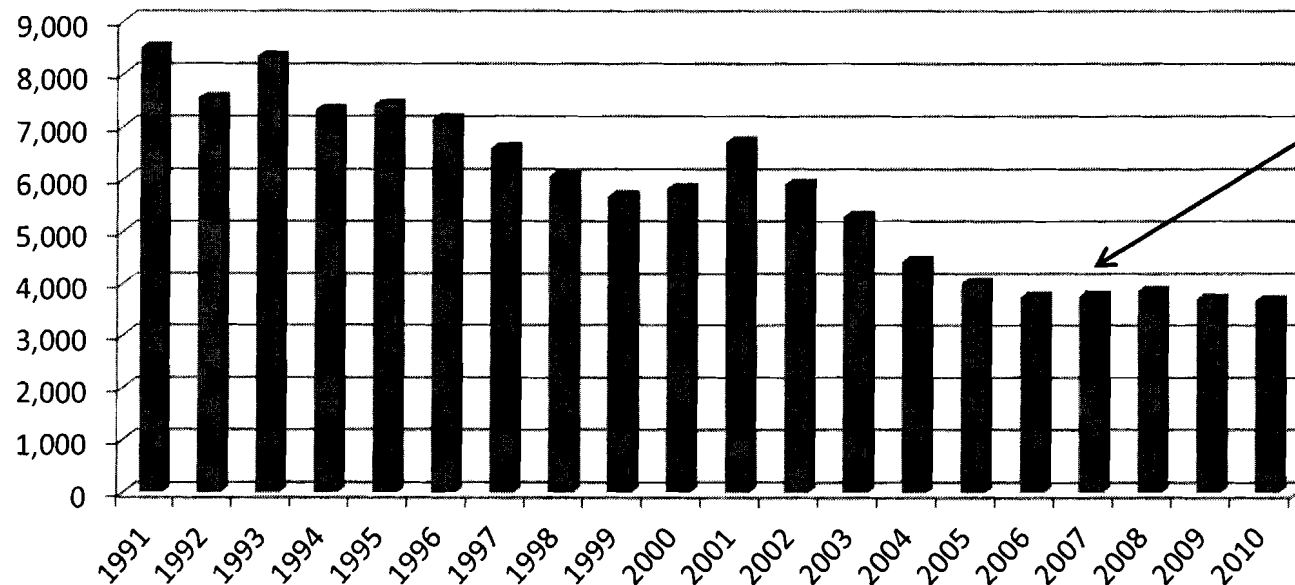


# PART ONE OFFENSES

- There were 3,669 Part I offenses in Alexandria during 2010, the lowest annual total since 1966.
- Since 2006, Annual Part I totals have been lower than 4,000 offenses.
- Part I offenses are classified as homicide, rape, robbery, felonious assault, burglary, larceny, and motor vehicle theft.

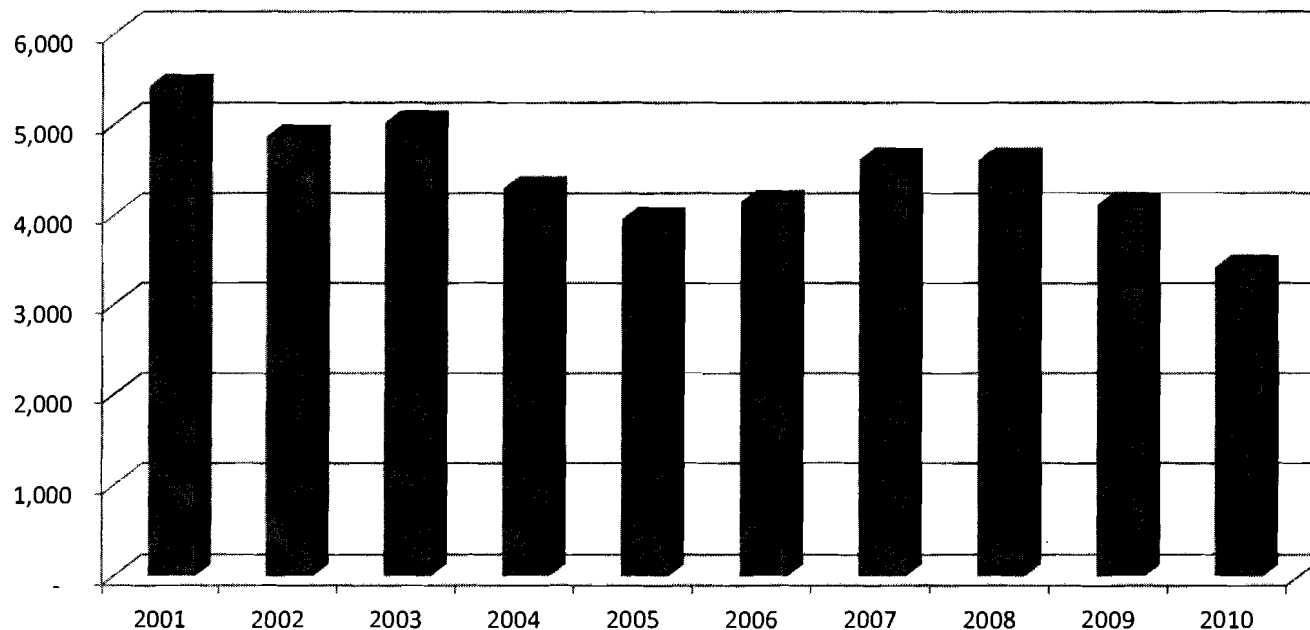


\* Strategic Response System implemented in 2007



# NUISANCE OFFENSES

- There were 3,419 Nuisance offenses in Alexandria during 2010, a 17% decline from 2009 and the lowest total in the last 10 years.
- Nuisance offenses are classified as destruction/vandalism, prostitution, drug/narcotic offenses, gambling, disorderly conduct, DUI, drunkenness and liquor law violations.

# Alexandria Fire Department 2010 SAFER Federal Grant Award

- FEMA funds of \$1,634,801 for Compensation for a Two-Year Period for 12 new Firefighters.
- City is Responsible for Third Year+.
- City Contributes \$376,923 for Training, Personal Protective Equipment, and Fringe Benefits. (Proposed Supplemental for FY 2012.)
- Unique, No-Match Funding Provided through ARRA Act (Federal Stimulus)
- City Has Previously Utilized the SAFER Program
- Recruit Class Proposed to Commence on July 1, 2011

# Alexandria Fire Department 2010 SAFER Federal Grant Award

- 12 Additional Firefighters will Bring Four Engines up to Four-Person Minimum Staffing.
- Upgraded Stations will be :
  - Station 206 (Seminary)
  - Station 207 (Duke Street)
  - Station 201 (Prince Street)
  - Station 205 (Cameron Street).
- Marks Progress in Responding to Council's Direction to Fulfill the Routley Report Recommendations.







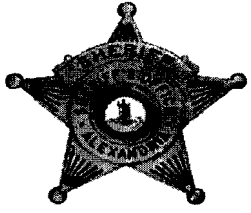


# Sheriff's Office Inmate Work Detail

| <u>Calendar Year</u> | <u>Hours Worked</u> | <u>Savings</u> |
|----------------------|---------------------|----------------|
| 2007                 | 4230                | \$115,902      |
| 2008                 | 9860.5              | \$270,177      |
| 2009                 | 7510                | \$205,774      |
| 2010                 | 8148                | \$223,255*     |

**\*The savings in 2010 is an 8.5% increase over savings in 2009**

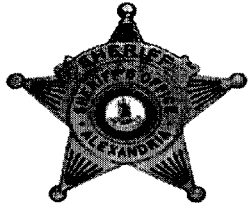

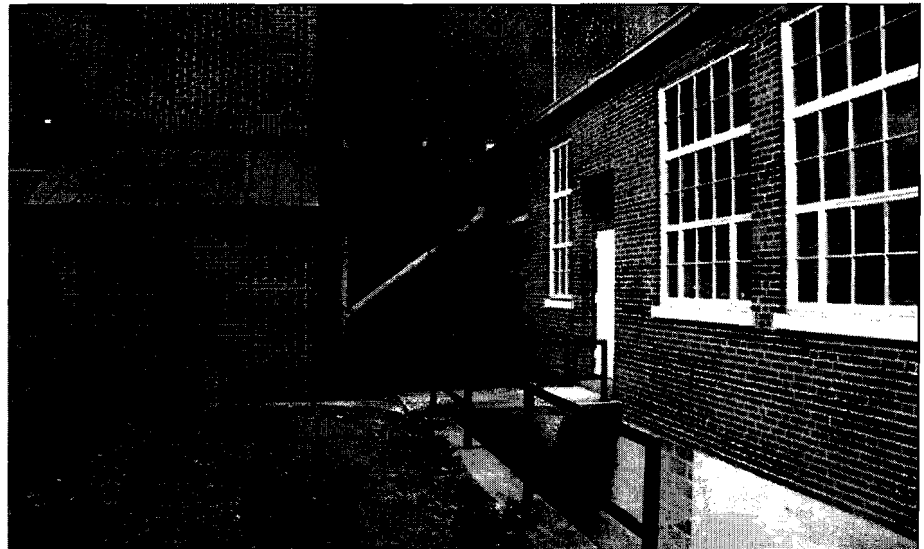
