Over 300 bicycle commuters are expected to attend this event sponsored by the City's departments of Transportation and Environmental Services and Recreation, Parks and Cultural Activities. Food and prizes will be provided to participants.

The dedication of the new Vola Lawson Animal Shelter is planned for Saturday, May 18, at 8:30 a.m. at 4101 Eisenhower Avenue.

The City's Annual USA/Alexandria Birthday Celebration will be held Saturday, July 6 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., at Oronoco Bay Park featuring the Alexandria Symphony Orchestra. The rain date is scheduled for Sunday, July 7 with the fireworks show only.
