Dear City Council,

The Residential Council of Old Town West along with petitions signed by over half of the residents, request the Alexandria City Council's attention to the need for speed humps and children playing caution signs on South Alfred Street between Wolfe and Gibbon.

On or around the 12th of May 2002, two young children ages 6 & 7 were hit and injured by a car that was traveling down S. Alfred Street at a speed that could have killed them. This location is highly populated with children of all ages who run back and forth to the ice-cream truck or play at the playground directly across the street from their homes.

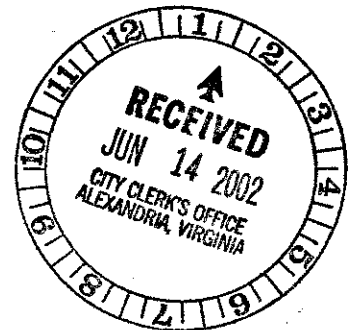
Daily, cars traveling on S. Alfred Street travel at an enormous speed with no awareness of children playing. Evening rush hour 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. is the height of playtime for most children in this area and Alfred street is also its busiest at rush hour as it is a short cut to traffic heading out of Old Town towards the beltway.

We are terribly concerned for our children and would like for the City to show its concern by granting us the needed speed humps and caution signs which will create awareness and force speeding traffic to slow down.
