
NOTICE OF MEETING

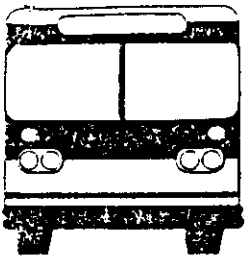
