BUDGET MEMO #18: DUNCAN LIBRARY EXPANSION AND RELATED

STATISTICS

At the March 19th budget work session when the Duncan Library Expansion was discussed, Library Director Patrick O'Brien orally made several statistical and financial comments that City Council Members requested be given to them in writing.

The first were circulation statistics:

The second was the statement that a two-floor Duncan expansion (as opposed to a one-floor expansion) would have not only program/space usage inefficiencies but would require additional staffing at an estimated cost of \$100,000 (for minimal aide staffing) to \$160,000 per year (for a professional librarian level of staffing). This equates to a \$2.0 million to \$3.2 million additional staffing cost over a 20 year period and indicates the high fiscal cost of a two-floor versus a one-floor expansion.
