It was been a real pleasure, thanks.

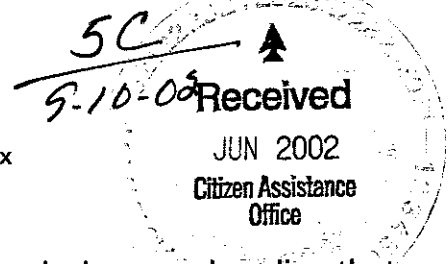

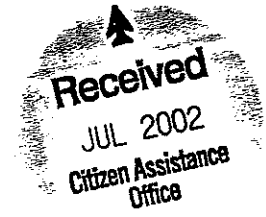
