ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council:

- (1) adopt the schedule of Council's regular City Council meetings for September 2003 through June 2004 (Attachment 1);
- (2) schedule a work session with the City's General Assembly delegation to discuss the City's 2004 Virginia General Assembly package at 6:00 p.m. before Council's legislative meeting on Tuesday, November 25; and
- (3) note the following events that are included on the Council Calendar:
 - the Festival of the Arts from Saturday, September 13 through Sunday, September 14 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.;
 - a joint community meeting sponsored by the Department of Planning and Zoning and the Alexandria City Public Schools on the new T.C. Williams High School proposal on Monday, September 15 at 7:30 p.m. in the T.C. Williams High School cafeteria, 3330 King Street;
 - the Citizenship Day event at 6:00 p.m. before Council's legislative meeting on Tuesday, September 23 on Market Square;
 - the City's fourth annual National Disability Mentoring Day, on Wednesday, October 15 with kickoff at 9:00 a.m. in the Vola Lawson Lobby;
 - the Jerome "Buddie" Ford Nature Center and William Ramsay School groundbreaking ceremony at 8:30 a.m. before Council's public hearing meeting on Saturday, October 18 at 5700 Sanger Avenue;
 - the Virginia Municipal League (VML) Annual Conference from Sunday, October 19 through Tuesday, October 21 in the Hotel Roanoke in Roanoke, Virginia;

- the 9th annual Walk to Fight Breast Cancer on Saturday, October 25, at 8:30 a.m. at Cameron Run Regional Park; and
- the 24th Annual Salute to Women Awards banquet on Monday, March 29, 2004 at the Holiday Inn Hotel and Suites, 625 First Street with the reception at 6pm and dinner at 7pm.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The attached calendar includes the schedule of Council meetings for September 2003 through June, 2004. We have listed a 7 p.m. start time for Council's legislative meetings on the calendar but have noted that this new start time is tentative pending the Saturday, September 13 public hearing and consideration of the ordinance changing the meeting time, which is to be introduced at the September 9 legislative meeting.

The calendar includes a Citizenship Day event which is scheduled for Tuesday, September 23 on Market Square. The event is intended to serve as an introduction to the City and welcome by the Mayor and Council for approximately 60 naturalized Alexandria citizens and their families. In case of inclement weather, the event will take place in the Vola Lawson Lobby.

The Council's annual work session with the City's General Assembly delegation provides an opportunity to discuss the City's 2004 Virginia General Assembly package with our delegation before Council's legislative meeting on Tuesday, November 25.

We will be returning to Council at the September 23 legislative meeting with the proposed dates for Council's annual retreat. Our goal is to schedule the retreat over a weekend in early November at a location in Alexandria.

At the first legislative meeting in October we will be proposing the schedule for the consideration of the FY 2005 budget including dates next spring for budget work sessions, the public hearing on the budget and budget adoption.
