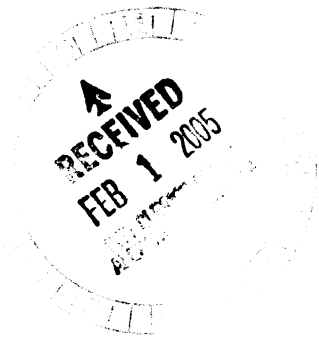
I apologize for any inconvenience this causes you, or the Commission, but hope we have a chance to work together in the future.
