ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council:

- 1) Schedule a work session on the presentation of the design work on Four Mile Run before its Tuesday, June 14 legislative meeting at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Work Room following the 6 p.m. reception for Alexandria Commission on Persons with Disabilities award winners; and
- 2) Note on your calendars that the All America City Award Competition will be held in Atlanta on Friday, June 24 and Saturday, June 25.

DISCUSSION: Mayor Euille requested that staff schedule a presentation to Council of the design work on the Four Mile Run project. I recommend that the presentation be set for 6:30 p.m. before Council's June 14 legislative meeting.

Alexandria is one of 30 finalists for the Award, which will be decided on Saturday, June 25 by a panel of judges selected by the National Civic League.
