## Alexandria Laundry Condominiums

- 69. All trees are to be limbed up a minimum of 6 feet as they mature to allow for natural surveillance.(Police)
- 70. No shrubs higher than 3 feet are to be planted within 6 feet of walkways.(Police)
- 71. Any proposed shrubbery is to have a maximum height of 36 inches when it matures.(Police)
- 72. <u>CONDITION AMENDED BY PLANNING COMMISSION:</u> Based upon the developer's offer of a voluntary contribution for affordable housing, \$24,000 will be provided. The applicant shall provide a voluntary contribution of \$24,000 to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund. (Housing)(PC)

Staff Note: In accordance with section 11-506(c) of the zoning ordinance, construction or operation shall be commenced and diligently and substantially pursued within 18 months of the date of granting of a special use permit by City Council or the special use permit shall become void.
