SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL SCHEDULE

**ISSUE:** City Council Schedule.

**RECOMMENDATION:** That City Council:

- (1) receive the revised calendar which includes the following additions:
  - this year's Metropolitan Council of Governments' Street Smart Pedestrian Campaign Launch in Alexandria on Tuesday, March 21 at 10:30 a.m. at the south entrance of the Pedestrian Concourse adjacent to the King Street Metro Station;
  - the 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work Day on Thursday, April 27. The kickoff will begin at 8:15 a.m. in the Vola Lawson Lobby;
  - Rebuilding Alexandria Together (formerly Christmas in April) on Saturday, April 29 (time and location to be determined);
  - the opening of the traveling panel exhibit by the Virginia Fine Arts, "Uncovering Home: A Visual Essay on Jamestown Archaeology" at 6:00 p.m. before Council's Tuesday, May 23 legislative meeting in the Vola Lawson Lobby; and
- (2) reschedule the Council tour of the Archives and Records Center for Thursday, May 18 at 7:30 p.m., which is also the meeting date of the Alexandria Public Records Advisory Commission.

**DISCUSSION:** The Metropolitan Council of Governments' Transportation Planning Board has selected Alexandria as the launch site for their 2006 Street Smart Pedestrian Safety Campaign. The event will take place on Tuesday, March 21.

The Office of Historic Alexandria is sponsoring a traveling panel exhibit by the Virginia Fine Arts entitled "Uncovering Home: A Visual Essay on Jamestown Archaeology". It will be shown in

conjunction with the arrival of the Godspeed. The official opening of the exhibit is scheduled for Tuesday, May 23 and will be displayed through July 6.
