**ISSUE:** City Council Schedule.

**RECOMMENDATION:** That City Council receive the revised calendar which includes the following additions:

- a reception sponsored by the Youth Policy Commission to honor youth as part of the annual National Youth Service Day observance before Council's legislative meeting on Tuesday, April 25 at 6:00 p.m. in the Vola Lawson Lobby;
- an open house for the Department of Human Services' new Child Assessment and Treatment Center for Health (CATCH) on Thursday, April 27, from 3:00 to 6:00 pm at 4480 King Street (the Health Department building); and
- the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Bike to Work Day on Friday, May 19 at Market Square.

**DISCUSSION:** The open house for the new Child Assessment and Treatment Center for Health is scheduled for Thursday, April from 3pm to 6pm at 4480 King Street. CATCH is a collaborative effort between the Department of Human Services, MH/MR/SA and the Health Department. The program provides for comprehensive physical, developmental, and emotional assessments of children 0-5 years of age. The particular at risk groups targeted are children in foster care and those who are subjects of Child Protective Services investigations or assessments.

The 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Bike to Work Day is scheduled for Friday, May 19 with a "pit stop" at 7:00 a.m. at Market Square. Council will receive a separate memorandum with details about this event.
