SUBJECT: CONSIDERATION OF AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE CAMERON STATION COMMUNITY CENTER AS A NEW POLLING PLACE AND ADJUST THE PRECINCT BOUNDARIES FOR THE SAMUEL B. TUCKER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, BEATLEY LIBRARY, AND SOUTH PORT POLLING PLACES

---

**ISSUE:** Consideration of an ordinance to establish the Cameron Station Community Center as a new polling place and to adjust the precinct boundaries for the Samuel B. Tucker Elementary School, Beatley Library, and South Port polling places (Attachment 1).

**RECOMMENDATION:** That City Council pass the ordinance on first reading and set it for public hearing, second reading and final passage on Saturday, November 12.

**BACKGROUND:** The Alexandria Electoral Board, which is comprised of three members who are appointed by the Alexandria Circuit Court for staggered three year terms, is responsible for making recommendations to City Council on changes in precinct boundaries and for establishing new precincts. Council has the authority to make these changes by ordinance.

State law requires the addition of a precinct or a change in precinct boundaries whenever the number of voters in any precinct for the Presidential Election exceeds 4,000. During the 2004 Presidential Election there were 3,653 voters at the Samuel B. Tucker Elementary School polling place, and, in light of recent growth, staff expects that the turnout in this precinct could exceed 4,000 during the 2008 Presidential Election if action is not taken before that time. This would require City Council to reduce the size of the Samuel B. Tucker Elementary School precinct within six months after the Presidential Election.

**DISCUSSION:** On October 18, 2005, the Alexandria Electoral Board voted to recommend that City Council add the Cameron Station Community Center, which is located at 200 Cameron Station Blvd., as a new polling place, and adjust the precinct boundaries for the Samuel B. Tucker Elementary School, Beatley Library, and South Port

polling places effective with the May 2006 City Council/School Board Election (Attachment 2). Although these adjustments are not currently required by law, the Electoral Board believes it would be necessary to make adjustments following the 2008 Presidential Election and recommends immediate action to address the growth in the Samuel B. Tucker Elementary School precinct, accommodate future growth, and reduce the size of the South Port precinct. This action would reduce delays for voters at each of these polling places. It is particularly important to reduce the size of the Tucker precinct because of the legal mandate and the South Port precinct because there is a small voting room at this location.

If Council approves this recommendation, the new Cameron Station Precinct would primarily be comprised of voters who live in Cameron Station and currently vote at Samuel B. Tucker Elementary School. Based on current data, the number of registered voters would be reduced from 5,567 to 3,910 at Samuel B. Tucker Elementary School, from 4,307 to 3,137 at South Port, and from 4,111 to 3,463 at Beatley Library. There would be 3,223 registered voters at the new Cameron Station Precinct (Attachment 3).

This action would not affect the City's School Board boundaries or the state House of Delegates or Senate boundaries. In addition, the recommended adjustments to precinct lines are based on census boundaries as required by State law.

If Council approves this ordinance, the United States Justice Department will also need to approve this request to facilitate the change in these polling places. The City Attorney has prepared the necessary submission for the Justice Department. In addition, after the request has been approved, the Electoral Board will send notifications to all of the registered voters in the affected precincts, and will also advertise the change in the local newspaper.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** It will cost approximately \$3,000 to send notifications to all of the registered voters in the affected precincts, and this can be absorbed in the Office of Voter Registration and Elections operating budget. The City also has backup voting equipment that can be assigned to the new Cameron Station Precinct.

INFORMATION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Title

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-2-10 (ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES), and to amend and reordain "The Official Map of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, Designating Election Districts and Voting Places," adopted by Section 2-2-13 (MAP OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES), all of Chapter 2 (ELECTIONS), Title 2 (GENERAL GOVERNMENT) of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, to establish a new Cameron Station Community Center Election District, and make corresponding boundary adjustments to the surrounding election districts.

Summary

The proposed ordinance establishes a new election district and polling place known as the Cameron Station Community Center Election District, and makes corresponding adjustments to the boundaries of the surrounding Tucker School, Beatley Library and South Port Election Districts. These changes are proposed in order better to accommodate the number of voters in these precincts. The proposed changes do not affect the boundaries of the Alexandria School Board Election Districts.

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-2-10 (ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES), and to amend and reordain "The Official Map of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, Designating Election Districts and Voting Places," adopted by Section 2-2-13 (MAP OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES), all of Chapter 2 (ELECTIONS), Title 2 (GENERAL GOVERNMENT) of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, to establish a new Cameron Station Community Center Election District, and make corresponding boundary adjustments to the surrounding election districts.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 2-2-10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained by adding thereto a new subsection (y) to read as follows:

(y) The Cameron Station Community Center Election District shall be bounded and described by the census blocks shown on the map adopted by section 2-2-13 of this code as comprising the said district.

The voting place within the Cameron Station Community Center Election District shall be at the Cameron Station Community Center, located at 200 Cameron Station Boulevard.

Section 2. That "The Official Map of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, Designating Election Districts and Voting Places," adopted by Section 2-2-13 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained as shown on Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated fully by reference, to reflect the designation and description of: the new Cameron Station Community Center Election District, and the corresponding adjustment to the boundaries of the Tucker School, Beatley Library and South Port Election Districts.

Section 3. That the general registrar of voters be, and he hereby is, directed to record the foregoing amendments on the said map.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the date and at the time of its final passage; provided, however, that the changes in the amendments herein made shall not be implemented until the changes are first submitted to the Attorney General of the United States and no objection is interposed within 60 days of the submission, as required pursuant to Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.
