Section 1. That the sunset date set forth in Section 4 of Ordinance No. 4457, be, and the same hereby is, extended from December 31, 2007 until December 31, 2008.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective on the date and at the time of its final passage, and shall apply, *nunc pro tunc*, to all applications for land use, land development or subdivision approval provided for under the City of Alexandria Zoning Ordinance which are on January 1, 2008, pending before any city department, agency or board, or before city council, shall apply to all such applications which may be filed after such date, and shall apply to all other facts and circumstances subject to the provisions of the City of Alexandria Zoning Ordinance, except as may be provided in Article XII of the Zoning Ordinance; provided, however, that this ordinance shall expire on December 31, 2008.
