  - Block 29 and 30
- Negotiate shared capacity with Fairfax County







### Uses:

- DRB review of all buildings and structures

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
# Potential Transfer of Floor Area

## ASA Master Plan Amendment

Note: Assumes Fairfax County remains at allocated capacity (32.4 MGD)

## ASA Master Plan Amendment

- Formulating comprehensive sanitary sewer model scope
- 2010 Budget will include Citywide sanitary sewer plan proposal
- Infrastructure analysis will be included within Small Area Plan.
- Future planning efforts will address pipe capacity as well as plant capacity.

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
