

SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL SCHEDULE

ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: That City Council receive the revised calendar which includes:

- a celebration rally in honor of the T.C. Williams Boys and Girls Varsity Basketball Teams on Market Square at 6:15 p.m. before Council's legislative meeting on Tuesday, March 25; and
- a change in the start time for the April 8 work session from 5:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. so that the work session can include two topics: (1) infill and (2) Planning and Zoning priorities.

DISCUSSION: On Tuesday night we will celebrate the outstanding seasons of our T.C. Williams High School Boys and Girls Varsity Basketball Teams with a rally in Market Square. The rally will follow at 6:15 p.m. after our 5:30 p.m. work session on the Community Environmental Health Assessment.
