WHEREAS, the United Nations has designated April 2 as World Autism Awareness Day; and

WHEREAS, the annual observance of the Autism Awareness Month advocates for the rights, human treatment, and appropriate education of all persons with autism, while educating families, professionals, and the general public to better understand this lifelong disability;
