## **INFORMATION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE**

### **Title**

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 12-7-12 (COMPOSITION; OFFICERS; APPOINTMENT, TERM AND COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS) of Article B (CONSUMER AFFAIRS COMMISSION), Chapter 7 (CONSUMER AFFAIRS), of Title 12 (EDUCATION, SOCIAL SERVICES AND WELFARE), of The Code of the City of Alexandria, 1981, as amended.

### Summary

The proposed ordinance revises the membership of the Consumer Affairs Commission, to permit the appointment of citizens at large in lieu of business representatives, if the positions for business representatives remain unfilled for three months, and to change one position for a consumer action organization representative to a citizen at large position. These changes were requested by the Consumer Affairs Commission.

That Section 12-7-12 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, 12 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained, to read as 13 follows: 14 15 Section 12-7-12 Composition; officers; appointment, term and compensation. 16 17 The commission shall consist of 11 members appointed by the city council; two of 18 whom shall be members of the business community, two one of whom shall be a 19 members of a local consumer action organizations and seven eight of whom shall be 20 citizens at large; provided, however, that one of the positions designated for a member of a local consumer action organization may be filled by a representative of a local non-21 profit organization which deals with consumer issues, or by an employee of a state or 22 federal agency which deals with consumer issues, and provided, further that the vacancy 23 24 for the consumer action organization member has been advertised and has remained unfilled for a period of three months or longer; and provided also that either or both of 25 the positions designated for a member of the business community may be filled by a 26 27 citizen at large, provided further that the vacancy for the business community member has been advertised and has remained unfilled for a period of three months or longer, and 28 such position shall revert to a position for a member of the business community upon the 29 expiration of the term of such appointee. All members shall be residents of the city; 30 except that one member of the business community and one the member of a consumer 31 action organization may be a nonresident of the city but a resident of the state. All 32 members shall be appointed by city council for three-year terms. Any vacancy shall be 33 filled by the council for the unexpired portion of a term. The commission shall select a 34 chairperson, vice chairperson and secretary by a majority vote of all members of the 35 commission. The chairperson shall serve a two-year term and may not succeed himself. 36 In the event that the chair is vacated for any reason, the vice chairperson shall succeed 37 and serve as chairperson for the remainder of the term. A vice chairperson shall be 38 selected by majority vote of all members of the commission to serve as vice chairperson 39 for the unexpired term.
