SUBJECT: RESOLUTION TO INCREASE EXCAVATION AND RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT FEES

ISSUE: Proposed increase in excavation and right-of way permit fees.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council adopt the resolution.

DISCUSSION: An increase in the excavation and right-of-way fees was reflected in the FY 2009 Adopted Budget as approved by City Council. These fee increases are proposed to begin on July 1, 2008. The table below indicates the current fees and proposed new fees:

FISCAL IMPACT: These fee increases will generate approximately \$57,020 of additional revenue starting in FY 2009 with no additional administrative cost.

RESOLUTION NO. _____

WHEREAS, under Section 2.07 of the City Charter, City Council has the authority to establish fees to be charged for services provided by the City; and

WHEREAS, under City Code Section 3-1-8(a), except as otherwise expressly provided in this code or in the zoning ordinance, all fees and charges for applications submitted to; for permits and approvals issued by, and for activities, programs and services provided by, the City of Alexandria shall be established by resolution of the City Council

WHEREAS, City Council has now determined that it is necessary and desirable to increase the excavation permit fee to \$100.00 and all other right-of-way permit fees to \$30.00;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED
BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA**

1. That, beginning in fiscal year 2009, the fee for excavation permits shall be \$100.00 per permit, and the fee for right-of-way permits shall be \$30.00 per permit.
2. That the fees established in Section 1 above shall apply to excavation permits and right-of-way permits and, unless and until revised by the City Council, to such services provided during subsequent fiscal years.
3. That this resolution shall be effective on the date and at the time of adoption.

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
