INFORMATION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Title

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 5-8-25 (REPOSSESSION OF IMPOUNDED VEHICLES; TOWING AND STORAGE CHARGES), of Article C (DISPOSITION OF ABANDONED, UNATTENDED AND IMMOBILE MOTER VEHICLES), Chapter 8 (PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) of Title 5 (TRANSPORTATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES) of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

Summary

The proposed ordinance increases towing fees and charges, for motor vehicles impounded by the City. Previously, the towing fee was \$75, plus a \$60 administrative charge. The new rate includes a towing fee of \$100, plus a \$70 administrative charge.

19	the owner and any person possessing a security interest in the vehicle shall be		
20	permitted to repossess the vehicle up to the time of its sale by:

22	(1)	payment of a towing charge of \$75 \\$100;	
23			
24	(2)	payment of a storage charge of \$30 per day;	
25			
26	(3)	payment of a charge of $\$60$ $\$70$ to cover the administrative costs incurred	
27		by the city in impounding the vehicle, in learning the identity of the	
28		vehicle owner and the holders of a security interest in the vehicle and in	
29		conducting the sale; and	
30			
31	(4)	in the case of vehicles identified in section 5-8-22(f), payment of the	
32		outstanding parking violation notices for which the vehicle was removed.

34	b) Payment of the charges and costs identified in subsection (a) shall not operate to		
35	relieve the owner of the impounded vehicle or the owner's agent from liability for any		
36	fine or penalty.
