GLEBE PARK REDEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS

At the October 13 public hearing, City Council deferred the Glebe Park applications and requested that staff provide additional information regarding the encroachments into the resource protection area (RPA) which was omitted within the earlier Council attachment. There was discussion about whether or not grass pavers may be used for the portion of emergency vehicle easement (EVE) turn-around that encroaches into the RPA. The EVE must serve fire trucks and other large service vehicles and therefore the area must attain an H₂0 load rating in order to support the weight of these vehicles. In order to maintain the H₂0 load rating to support such vehicles, the base material must be consolidated. Therefore, there is no increase in pervious surface area even with the use of pavers or other like surfaces.
